NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Plainfield Public Library is accepting sealed bids for moving services in connection with the 2024 Library Renovation Project at the Plainfield Public Library. Bid packages are available for pickup from the Plainfield Public Library at 15025 S. Illinois Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544, and on the Library's website at https://papl.info/about/transparency-dashboard/.

Optional pre-bid meeting February 6, 2024 at 12:00 p.m. in the Small Meeting Room at the Plainfield Public Library.

Deadline for submitting bids is Friday, February 16, 2024 at 4:00 p.m.

Bid opening is scheduled for Monday, February 19, 2024 at 1:00 p.m. in the Small Meeting Room at the Plainfield Public Library.



INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- Scope and Term of Services. Plainfield Public Library (the "Library") is accepting sealed bids for the moving services (the "Services") as required for the Library's 2024 Renovation Project, which is located at 15025 S. Illinois Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544.
- 2. <u>Contact Information.</u> Questions about this bid package must be emailed to the Library's Director, Lisa Pappas, at <u>lpappas@papl.info</u> by February 9, 2024 at 12:00 p.m. The Library will endeavor to respond to all timely questions, and will circulate all responses to all interested bidders who have provided the Library with contact information. Any modifications to this bid package shall only be made by written addendum.
- 3. <u>Pre-Bid Meeting.</u> An optional pre-bid meeting and walk through will be held on Tuesday, February 6, 2024 at 12:00 p.m. in the Small Meeting Room at the Library, located at 15205 S. Illinois Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544.
- 4. <u>Notification of Addenda.</u> The Library will notify all potential bidders who have provided contact information in the event of any addenda issued. The bidder shall acknowledge receipt of all addenda in the place provided on the bid form.
- 5. <u>Tax Exempt.</u> The Library is tax-exempt. Bidder shall prepare its bid accordingly. The Library's tax exemption number is E99004319.
- 6. <u>Bid Preparation.</u> All bidders shall complete and submit all forms provided in this bid package. All forms shall be free from interlineations and erasures. Failure to properly complete and return all forms may subject the bid to rejection. Each bid submittal with all completed forms shall be sealed in an opaque envelope and labeled "BID FOR MOVING SERVICES DO NOT OPEN PRIOR TO BID DATE". Each bid submittal shall be labeled with the name and address of the bidder and shall be addressed to Lisa Pappas, Director, Plainfield Public Library, 15025 S. Illinois Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544.
- 7. <u>Bid Bond.</u> Not applicable.
- 8. Non-Conforming Bids. Any bid submittal that contains or purports to contain qualifications, terms, conditions, or provisions in addition to or in conflict with this bid package, or that omits required information or documents, may be rejected by the Library as non-responsive. Any bid that omits bid pricing for any part or parts of the base bid and/or any alternate shall be automatically rejected as non-responsive.
- 9. <u>Bid Submittal.</u> All bids shall be submitted to Lisa Pappas, Director, Plainfield Public Library, 15025 S. Illinois Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544. The deadline for submitting bids is Friday, February 16, 2024 at 4:00 p.m.



- 10. <u>Bidder's Representation.</u> By submitting a bid, the bidder represents to the Library that it was given the opportunity to attend the optional pre-bid meeting and walk-through, and that it has carefully reviewed this bid package, and is not aware of any vague, ambiguous or inconsistent terms contained herein.
- 11. Withdrawal of Bids. Any bid may be withdrawn and/or resubmitted prior to the time of bid opening.
- 12. <u>Bid Opening.</u> On February 19, 2024, at 1:00 p.m., all bids will be opened and read aloud by an employee or agent of the Library. The bid opening will occur in the Small Meeting Room at the Library, located at 15025 S. Illinois Street, Plainfield, Illinois 60544.
- 13. <u>Firm Bids.</u> All bids submitted to and opened by the Library shall be firm and irrevocable for a period of sixty (60) days after the date of bid opening. At any time within this period, the Library may award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.
- 14. <u>Acceptance or Rejection of Bids.</u> The Library reserves the right to waive any non-material variances in bid submittals and/or irregularities in the bid process, to award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, and/or to reject all bids, all to the fullest extent allowed by law.
- 15. Award of Contract. The Library's Board of Trustees will review all bids and may award the contract to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The lowest bid will be determined as specified in the attached bid form. Responsiveness will be determined based upon compliance with the instructions to bidders. Responsibility will be determined by the Library based upon the information provided by each bidder with its bid submittal. Upon receiving notice of such award, the successful bidder shall be known as the "Contractor," and shall be bound to perform the duties established by this bid package, including without limitation the duties established in the Instructions to Bidders, Conditions of the Contract, Contract Specifications, and Addenda, if any.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

- Prevailing Wages. Contractor shall pay prevailing wages, and shall make, keep and file certified payroll, and shall comply with all requirements of the Prevailing Wage Act, 820 ILCS 130/0.01 et seq. Prevailing wage rates for this project are available here: https://idol.aem-int.illinois.gov/content/dam/soi/en/web/idol/laws-rules/conmed/documents/fy24/20240119/Will.pdf
- 2. **Record Keeping.** Contractor shall keep complete and accurate records of all work performed in connection with the Services. Contractor shall provide the Library access to such records upon a request by the Library.
- 3. <u>Right to Audit.</u> The Library may audit the Contractor's records related to the Services. Contractor shall fully cooperate with all personnel authorized by the Library to conduct any audit.
- 4. <u>Records Retention.</u> Contractor shall retain such records related to the Services for a period of three (3) years after completion of the Services, or a longer period if required by law. If any audit has been requested and is not completed, the records shall be retained beyond the three (3) year period as long as required for completion of the audit.
- 5. <u>Payment and Performance Bonds.</u> Not applicable.
- No Delegation or Assignment. Contractor shall not assign any right or delegate any
 duty under this contract to any third party without the Library's prior written consent.
 Any attempted assignment or delegation without such prior written consent shall be
 void.
- 7. **No Third Party Beneficiaries.** There are no third party beneficiaries to this contract.
- 8. <u>Independent Contractor.</u> Contractor is an independent contractor and not an agent of the Library. Contractor's employees are not employees of the Library and are not entitled to salary or benefits from the Library. Contractor has no authority to act on behalf of the Library except to the limited extent required by this contract. Contractor shall not represent to any third person that Contractor or any of its employees are agents of the Library.
- 9. <u>Waiver.</u> The Library's waiver of any breach or default under any provision of this contract shall not be deemed to constitute a waiver of such provision for any subsequent breach or default of the same or any other provision. The disbursement or acceptance of any payment by the Library shall not be deemed to constitute a waiver of any prior occurring breach or default by Contractor of any provision of the contract regardless of the knowledge of the Library of such breach or default at the time of its disbursement or acceptance of such payment.



10. <u>Indemnity.</u> Contractor shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Library, its Board of Trustees, individual board members, administrators, employees, agents and representatives (collectively the "Indemnitees") from and against any and all claims, demands, causes of action, losses, liabilities, and damages, including reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs, to the extent arising from Contractor's performance and/or breach of this contract, or from any negligent act or omission of the Contractor or its employees or subcontractors.

Defenses and Immunities. No term or condition of this contract is intended to or

- 11. shall be deemed to waive any common law or statutory immunity or defense available to the Library, and the Library expressly reserves all applicable immunities and defenses.
- 12. Insurance. Contractor shall procure and maintain through an insurance company or companies licensed to conduct business in Illinois insurance with coverage and limits as specified below, and shall cause "Plainfield Public Library" to be included as an additional insured on these policies by endorsement. All such insurers shall carry a Best Key Guide Rating of A / VIII. The commercial general liability and automobile policies shall be endorsed to reflect that coverage is primary and noncontributory with respect to any other insurance available to the Library. The commercial general liability policy shall by endorsement provide contractual liability coverage including the indemnity obligations provided in this contract.

Each such policy shall include by endorsement a requirement of at least 30 days' written notice to the Library prior to any termination, cancellation or material amendment to that policy. Upon award of this contract, and promptly upon the renewal of such policies during the term of this contract, Contractor shall furnish certificate(s) of insurance, policies, and endorsements to the Library reflecting the coverages required.

The type and limits of insurance required are as follows:

Commercial General Liability

Per Occurrence: \$1,000,000

Aggregate: \$3,000,000

Automobile Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit

Workers' Compensation: Statutory Limit

13. <u>Payment.</u> On a monthly basis during performance of the contract, Contractor shall furnish detailed monthly invoices to the Library in a form acceptable to the Library. The Library may at any time direct Contractor to change the formatting of its invoices or to add more details as required by the Library. Contractor shall deliver invoices to the Library no later than the first day of each month. The Library will



process invoices in accordance with the Local Government Prompt Payment Act, 50 ILCS 505/1, et seq.

- 14. <u>Termination</u>. The Library may terminate this contract at any time, for any reason or no reason, in the Library's sole discretion, upon written notice to Contractor. If such termination is without cause, the Library will pay for the value of Services rendered up until the date of termination. If such termination is based on the Contractor's material breach of contract, the Library shall have no further obligation to pay Contractor. Whether or not the Library exercises such right of termination, Contractor hereby waives any claim against the Library related to incidental, consequential, or special damages, including and not limited to lost profits.
- 15. <u>Prevailing Party.</u> In the event of any litigation, arbitration, or binding dispute resolution arising from this contract, Contractor shall pay the Library's reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs to the extent the Library is determined to be the prevailing party.
- 16. Choice of Law. This contract shall be governed by, subject to, and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois without regard to conflict of law principles. Venue for any dispute shall be Will County, Illinois. Contractor hereby consents to personal jurisdiction in Illinois with respect to all claims arising from this contract.
- 17. Integration. This contract includes the Instructions to Bidders, these Conditions of Contract, and the Contract Specifications, all as contained in this bid package; together with any later-issued Addenda, Contractor's Bid Submittal, and the Library's Notice of Award, these documents are collectively known as the "contract" or "Contract Documents." The Contract Documents constitute the entire agreement between the Library and Contractor with respect to their subject matter and supersede any prior oral or written agreement between the parties. This contract may not be canceled or amended orally, but only by the subsequent written agreement of both parties.
- 18. <u>Execution of Contract</u>. Upon the Library's notice of award of this contract to the Contractor, Contractor's bid shall be deemed accepted and a binding contract shall be formed, consisting of the Contract Documents.

CONTRACT SPECIFICATIONS

Basic Description of Activities

The Plainfield Area Public Library is completing a full interior renovation of its 27,000 square foot building and adding a 3500 square foot addition. The Library will operate out of the upper floor for the first phase of the renovation and then the lower level for the second part of the renovation.

During the first phase, a portion of the collections on the lower level will be moved to the upper level and portions of the collections on both floors will need to be stored offsite in contractor-supplied storage. For the second phase, the shelving stored in Phase 1 will be brought back, and the collections on the upper level will be moved to the lower level. At the end of renovation, the items in storage will be returned and distributed to their new locations.

Moving Services – Base Bid

- 1. **Phase 1** (Between April 29 and May 7, 2024)
 - a. Tagging, packing and relocation of approximately 50-60,000 items of the Library's collections and other library materials from the Plainfield Public Library first and second floors to Contractor-supplied temperature controlled off-site storage.
 - b. Tagging, packing and relocating to Contractor-supplied temperature controlled off-site storage a microfilm reader and six cabinets of microfilm, a small number of seating/tables.
 - Disassemble, pack, remove and store the following, located in the Lower Level:
 - i. 24 shelving sections measuring 35" w x 9" D x 66" tall. Each section has 10 shelves and associated brackets.
 - ii. 9 shelving sections measuring 35"w x 11"D x 42" tall. Each section has 6 shelves and associated brackets.
 - iii. 3 shelving sections measuring 35"W x 9" D x 42" tall. Each section has 6 shelves and associated brackets.
- 2. Phase 2 (Late November 2024 December 2024)
 - a. Deliver, assemble and install the shelving from Contractor-supplied storage from Phase 1 on the Library's Lower Level where operations will be moved to for the next phase of renovation.
 - b. Disassemble, pack, remove and store the following, located on the Upper Level:



- i. 29 shelving sections measuring 35" w x 9" D x 90" tall. Each section has 84 shelves and associated brackets.
- ii. 5 shelving sections measuring 35"w x 9"D x 90" tall. Each section has 7 shelves and associated brackets.
- iii. 24 shelving sections measuring 35"W x 11" D x 42" tall. Each section has 2 shelves and associated brackets.
- iv. 3 shelving sections measuring 35"W x 11"D x 42" tall.

Each section has 6 shelves and associated brackets.

3. **Phase 3** (Late April 2025 – May 2025)

With renovations complete, return the upper level shelving in order to have new end caps installed by the shelving vendor. Then, return all stored collections to the shelving on both levels; new shelving will have been installed on the lower level.

Alternates

1. Alternate 1

A-1. Phase 1 (May 2024)

Tagging, packing and relocation of approximately 50-60,000 items of library materials from the Plainfield Public Library to a temporary location at the Joliet Public Library 150 N. Ottawa Street, Joliet IL 60432. Microfilm reader and other furniture items are to be stored in Contractor-supplied temperature controlled offsite storage. Once renovations are complete, items will be packed and transported back to the Plainfield Public Library and unpacked on to new shelving. If accepted, this alternate will replace 1a and 1b from Phase 1 in the base bid.

2. Alternate 2

A-2. Phase 2 Add-on

Remove all library materials remaining on the Upper Level and transfer to shelving on the Lower Level in sorted order.

Moving Services—Bidder Competencies

Please be advised. Library moves are specialized. Firms bidding on this project must be capable of performing an organized, coordinated move of library materials. Failure to properly execute the move, including all organizational aspects and the correct placement of materials, may be considered a breach of contract. The successful bidder will need to do the following or have the following capabilities:

a. Engage in pre-move meetings for each phase with library staff to assist with move planning, scheduling, and sequencing.



- b. Employ color-coding systems and/or numbering systems that properly identify all items and provide the correct placement of those items in each new facility over the course of the moves for each phase.
- c. Use non-skid, non-marring moving dollies and other equipment.
- d. Use equipment facilitating the safe and proper move of library-specific storage such as microform cabinets, microfilm reader, and other similar library furniture and equipment.
- e. Use proper ramping, if and where needed, that is designed and fitted to the Plainfield Area Public Library building's specific needs.
- f. Use moving containers designed for library materials, library-specific supplies, library shelving and the relocation of library furniture.
- g. Provide for the proper installation, disassembly, moving, and reassembly of library shelving units
